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
Language Level Assessment

- In order to determine objectively the level of English of your students
- j you need: objective standards and determiners: CEF
- an objective tool: The Deviant Language Level Assessment tool (LLA)

- Listening skill tasks
- Reading skill tasks
- Language structure tasks
- Vocabulary tasks
- Results presented in CEF levels A1, A2, B1-, B1+, B2, C1, C2
- Results stored digitally (on line)

How to organise LLA at school

- 1 4 assessment sessions of 20 minutes (e.g. in introduction week)
- 2 Afterwards: possible to group students in CEF level groups (and level 0)
- 3 Possible to organise learning processes both in groups and individually.
- 4 And any possible mix of these.

What to do with level 0?



Level 0 - A1

- How to enable level 0 students to participate?
- Start from scratch
- Take TIME
- Use Starters

What is Starters?

Basic English language skills



- Practice-, test- en assessment-programme
- From level 0 to CEF level beginners A1

Content Starters



Contents Starters

- Starters contains clear and concrete language material
- 500 very frequently occurring words:
 - people, animals, objects, possessions, directions
 - indicating, mentioning things, summing up
 - warning
 - (not) wanting something
 - comparing (+ numbers)
 - (re)acting
 - time
 - describing
- Frequently used phrases
- No interaction in groups
- Basic telephone conversation skills

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Components digital version Starters

- Aptitude test consisting of:
 - Reading tasks
 - Listening tasks
 - Language structure tasks
 - Vocabulary tasks
- 2. Training (skills, structure and words)
- 3. Final test: covers same skills as aptitude test (Final test only visible if sub tests were OK)
- Language Level Assessment CEF beginners A1





- Identical to digital version
- Printed and downloadable booklet with:
 - a minimum of theory
 - maximal clarity: examples and pictures
 - recurring excercises (cycles of learning)
 - digital test + assessment at CEF level beginners A1
- Teacher's guide:
 how to work with Starters, answers, tips





- Bold letter type
- Lots of white on the pages
- Didactic use of illustrations



Good Practice





Working with multi-level groups

- How to work with groups of students comprising various levels?
- Use Good Practice,
 a course which combines CEF level A2 B2

What is Good Practice?



- Good Practice: Dutch mbo levels 2, 3 and 4
- Good Practice: CEF levels A2-B2
- Each student works at his / her own level in books and on web site
- Tasks at each level take approx. the same time
- This offers possibilities for various ways of organising the learning process





How to work with GP – an example

- Suppose you have 4 groups, 4 teachers and 4 hours of English on the time table
- Possibility:
 - 2 groups working individually in computer room with1 teacher
 - 2 groups being taught in classrooms with 2 teachers
 - 1 teacher available for specific help for groups of 5-8 students





Contents Good Practice Basic Workbook

- Basic English skills, words and structures
- Six units with tasks relevant to all professions
- Uniform structure:
 - grouped by skill and level
 - order: Training Selftest Final Task
- The school approach determines in which order the language material is used

Good Practice Checkbook



Contents Good Practice Basic Checkbook

- Audioscripts
- **Reading texts**
- **KGrammar**
- Word lists per unit
- Dictionary English-Dutch and D-E
- **&** Expressions
- Explanations and answers



Contents Good Practice Studiemeter.nl



- Language structure tasks
- Spelling tasks
 - Vocabulary tasks:
 - 1. context sentences 2. meanings
- Audio tasks
- **f** Extra:
 - downloadable glossaries, tests + answers, dictionary
 - Option to add words and texts yourself



Summary

- You need professional skills for the various work processes
- In these work processes various aspects of professional skills are required
- Language skills can be part of those requirements
- However: if they aren't, command of English is still a necessity for all European citizens



The Good Practice solution

- With Good Practice students learn English, not a profession.
- Contents of *GP* provide the professional context, though!
- General professional context in basic Checkbook & Workbook.
- Professional context specific for 10 sectors in booklets "Uitstroomkaternen".





The choices of Good Practice

- Balanced use of books and computer
- Communication also with "live" interaction
- Flexible tool suitable for:
 - individuals
 - groups
 - remedial teaching
 - basic vocational English: levels 0 B1
 - specific vocational English: levels B1-C2
- Tasks can be included in a digital portfolio
- CEF level assessment with Deviant LLA tool.



GP: Testing and Assessing

- "On the way" (aptitude tests): Selftest and Studiemeter.nl
- Exam tests (proof for qualification):
 - downloadable integrated tests
 - Final Tasks in Workbook
- Possible to add results to European Language portfolio
- Tests to be validated by Dutch department of Education by January 2008



Good Practice aptitude tests

- Test units of 20 minutes
- Digital and paper versions;
- A- en B-versions
- Mords, speech functions, grammar)
- Skills tests (reading, listening, speaking, writing)



Good Practice qualification tests

Integrated tests for each sector

Combination of knowledge and skills

Validated by January 2008



Good Practice Uitstroomkaternen

- 3 booklets annually for each sector
- Available levels October 2007: A2 B1
- Organising principle:
 - preparatory language tasks
 - followed by professional / vocational tasks requiring language skills
- Checkbook: reference function



Each booklet has the same build-up

- 1. Starting out with vocabulary tasks
- 2. Next: preparatory language tasks
- 3. Vocational tasks requiring language
- 4. Final Task where possible

The completed tasks are the proof of the pudding.

Checkbook is used for reference.
