1 Introduction to the TextBlender, version 1.0

1.1 What kind of tool is the Webpage TextBlender?

The Webpage TextBlender (WPTB) is a tool for students and teachers which is used as part of a (language) learning process. Students may e.g. find it very useful to make presentations for fellow students and/or teachers. The WPTB makes it possible to share texts, images and videos with other users online. Teachers may e.g. find it useful as a tool used for teaching a foreign language. The WPTB makes it possible to link all the words in a text to online dictionaries. This will not only save much time for students when trying to read and understand a text, but it gives them also a far better chance of finding the *right* translation for the context. Instead of using their own dictionary, they now have an indefinite number at their disposal on the internet.

This is an example of a final webpage we made with the TextBlender:

Title ← **Soccer bloopers**

Video Clip (media) ← 

Task ← **Why is soccer so popular?**

Click on a word to look it up in the dictionary

Soccer's popularity can be explained in a little phrase that, to me, perfectly captures its joyful simplicity, jumpers for goalposts. If you have a ball you can play soccer, no equipment is needed, no special preparation. You don't even need an opponent; a wall will do to hone one's soccer skills. Apart from jumpers, traffic cones, trees and bags are perfectly acceptable goal posts and whatever you're wearing is suitable attire, although mothers of the world universally despair at grass stains all over those new trousers. The pitch can be sized, and resized mid-game, to accommodate any number of players from two to thirty.

Text. Every word in this text is linked with an online dictionary. Here we chose for an online English – Dutch dictionary.

Aim of this manual:

To teach you step-by-step how you can create your own Webpage

1.2 *Creating a WPTB project folder before you start*

To create your webpage and to have an overview of the graphics, photos etc and files that you create, we advise you strongly to create a WPTB project folder on your desktop.

Instructions: Go to your desktop and right-click on your mouse

 Choose NEW → and then FOLDER

 Name the folder WPTB

 Save all files you need to download (webpage, graphics, sound and video) in this folder

2 Downloading the NEURON plugin before you start

If your college doesn't have the tool **NEURON** plugin on its server, or you are working at home, then you need to download a small tool before you start creating a webpage.

Instructions:

Open the website <http://www.languages.dk/tools/index.htm>

Scroll down to the middle of the page until you find this text:

To run the online versions you need to install a Neuron plugin (only once)

- **Download and install the 8.6 version of the Neuron plugin**

Click on the link and follow the instructions to download the NEURON plugin.

Every time you open the latest version WPTB, you will see the NEURON plugin logo on your screen first.



You can also install the TextBlender software from a CD. In that case you do not need the Neuron plugin. The Neuron plugin is only needed if you have not installed the full TextBlender program from a CD

3 Downloading the latest version of the Webpage TextBlender

This manual deals with the TextBlender v. 1.0 which can be downloaded from http://www.languages.dk/tools/index.htm#The_Web_Page_Text_Blender

After installing the Neuron plugin you can launch the Text Blender in a web browser by clicking on the link below

- **Newest Blender version (August 18th 2009)** This version is labelled TextBlender 1.0 and supports several types of fonts. The TextBlender v.1.0 supports graphics, it can use videos from Youtube and Video.Google. It has corrected dictionary links for several languages



We develop The TextBlender on an almost daily basis so we advise you to regularly check for updates and new version in the project website, <http://www.languages.dk>. However, it may be a long time before a new version is published.

4 Selecting an interface language

After installation and startup this is the welcome screen:



In version 1.0 there are two buttons “Dansk grænseflade” and “English interface” and there are three navigation buttons in navigation panel: (see right hand bottom corner)



The top navigation button  takes you to a top menu

The middle button  takes you one step BACK

The bottom button  moves you to the NEXT step, but in some cases you may be told that you need to select and item before you can continue



5 Selecting the media for your webpage




Next step is to decide which media you want in the final webpage (if any). There are four buttons with media options:

- **No Media** Click on this if you do NOT choose for any media (video, picture, audio) to be part of the webpage you are creating. The next page will be opened automatically.
- **Video player** Click on this button to choose a video player. Clicking on this button takes you through some steps where you choose the video to play in your webpage.
- **Audio Player** Click on this button to choose an audio player. Clicking on this button takes you through some steps where you choose the sound file to play in your webpage.
- **Video player for Youtube, etc.** Click on this button to choose for a video from sources such as YouTube and google Video. Clicking on this button takes you through some steps where select the video file to play in webpage.



You cannot move forward to the next step before you have chosen one of the four options!!

5.1 Selecting a video player



If you clicked on **“Video Player”** then you need to choose between using a local video file, (that is a file on your PC), and an internet video file, that you need to download from Internet.




What is the difference between a local video and an Internet video?

If you like other people to see your video file, then you need to save it in a place where other users can see it while sitting behind their own PC. So, if you choose a video that is saved on your own hard disk (the D: drive on your PC), then other people will not be able to see it. This happens when you choose a “local” video file.

If you wish to share your video with others, you need to save it on a server. For example, if you choose a YouTube video file, then everybody will be able to see your video file in your webpage.


5.1.1 Choosing a local video file



Filename with spaces are not allowed, so you may have to rename a file.
E.g. Your file *My Name.wmv* becomes *MyName.wmv*

5.1.2 Choosing an internet video file

You can also use a video from the Internet if you know the full address (URL) of that video:




Instructions:

1. Choose a video file and give it a name
For example: **.wmv* becomes *myvideo.wmv*
Or: **.avi* becomes *myvideo.avi*
2. Save the file in the WPTB folder on your PC

5.2 Selecting an Audio player

If you have chosen to have an audio file play in the final webpage the options are quite similar to the video options



Filename with spaces are not allowed, so you may have to rename a file.
E.g. Your file *My Name.wma* becomes *MyName.wma*

Instructions:

1. Choose an audio file and give it a name
For example: *.wav becomes *mysound.wav*
2. Save the file in the WPTB folder on your PC

5.3 Selecting a YouTube or Google video

The final media option is to use media from e.g. Youtube.com, Google, or similar video services.

5.3.1 Copying the "embed" information to your webpage

In Google, Youtube, and in most other video websites you have to look for an "Embed video" option.

Look at the example below. On the right of the video it says URL and below EMBED. If you wish to choose this video file for your webpage you need to copy the EMBED information to your webpage.



6 Instructing the user of your webpage

Now you have selected the media you wish to use in your webpage. Next, it's time to instruct the users of your webpage. These may be students, but they could also be teachers.

There are many uses of the TextBlender. After having selected media the next step is to fill in information and instruction for the end user.

Look at the sample webpage below. You see two columns. In the **LEFT** column you see instructions that ask you to fill in text. In the **RIGHT** column you see how your text shows up in your final webpage.



6.1 Understanding the instructions

Let's have a closer look at the instructions in the **LEFT** column:

This is very often the title of your assignment. E.g.: *Unit 2* or *War Games in the USA*

Often the instruction here is: ***Click on a word to find its meaning***

If your webpage is part of more exercises which the user can find on another webpage, then you need to type the web address here.


If you use text from a source, it may be necessary to mention the source. E.g.: *Source: CNN, 20 May 20..*

7 Selecting an online dictionary

The TextBlender has a number of online dictionaries to choose from. These dictionaries make it possible to translate from one European language into another:






If you choose one of the dictionaries, then simply highlight it and click the  button in the navigation panel.

If you want to add a new dictionary, you have to click the  button (“Edit or create a new blank dictionary link”)

7.1 Installing an online dictionary

If you have clicked the  (“Edit or create a new blank dictionary link” button), you will see the screen below. It’s now possible to install a new dictionary.



From this page you can install a new dictionary link or update an existing link.

Some online dictionaries change their behaviour from time to time, but from this page you can "repair" or update the link which does not work properly.



7.2 The function of buttons when installing a new online dictionary

Often you will choose one of the dictionaries in this TextBlender. However, as you have seen, it is possible to install your own. When you install a new online dictionary, the navigation buttons have a different function than described before. At this stage,



the “Menu” button takes you back to the “Select a dictionary page”

the “BACK” button takes you to the previous dictionary so you can see its settings

the “NEXT” button takes you to the next dictionary so you can see its settings. This is the final button to press after installation of or editing a dictionary

At the bottom of the page there are three more buttons:



1. “Create new dictionary page” this will result in a new page where you have to insert information about the new dictionary
2. “Update or install the dictionary page” This will apply the changes you have made and enable the new dictionary (if you have made one)
3. “Delete the dictionary page” simply removes a dictionary, this cannot be undone!




If you cannot find the search word in the browser address line, then you could try and right click the area in your browser with the resulting dictionary lookup and select “Properties”. If you find the word here, then just copy the properties and paste it into the “Dictionary URL field”

8 Inserting Text and graphics in your webpage

In this version of the TextBlender, 1.0, it's possible to insert a maximum of 5 texts and 5 images. If you do not want an image in the start of the page, then just ignore the first "Choose image 1" button.

If you want the page to start with two images and then text, you make use of the first two "Choose image buttons" and insert the text by clicking "Input text part 3". Each text part can be up to approximately 30.000 characters including spaces and empty lines between paragraphs. Our advice is to keep the texts short.



Filenames with spaces are not allowed, so you may have to rename a file!







8.2 Inserting a text

In the TextBlender it makes a difference whether you TYPE text yourself or you PASTE it. (see 8.3)

If you TYPE the text yourself, click on the  (input text) button and the following box appears. Fill in your text.




When you have clicked the “Input text part 1” button you come to this page. You can see which text block you have chosen, in this case “Text block 1”.

8.3 Pasting a copied text

If you PASTE a text as, then follow the instructions below:

8.3.1 Creating a headline

If you want a text line in the text to become a headline you have to insert an * (say: asterix) in front of that text, e.g. **This becomes a headline*


To finish the text editing, click on the button

Click when the text is ready

8.4 Changing the FONT of your text


If some characters do not appear properly you can click the button

Change the text font



9 Creating the final webpage

The final part of the work is to create the webpage.
Click the button labeled “Create and save webpage” and save the *.htm* file



When you have clicked “Create and save webpage” you have to decide where you want to save the resulting webpage. The media and graphics you have selected will then be copied to that directory.

N.B. it may take some time to copy e.g. large video files to the selected directory, so patience, please!-)
